Exemptions from sitting the National Examinations are permitted under Article 39 of the Compulsory School Act, No 91/2008. According to the Act, headteachers may exempt pupils from undergoing National Examinations where objectively justified and as consented by parents.

- Students whose native language is not Icelandic may be exempted from sitting the National Examination in Icelandic. Students who have resided in Iceland for less than a year may also be granted an exemption from the National Examinations in mathematics and English.
- Students of compulsory school age who are considered to have a developmental delay of a type that makes the National Examinations unsuitable for them may be exempted from the examinations.
- Students who, as a result of a physical or psychological trauma, are incapable of appearing for the National Examinations may be exempted from them.
